General Rules

The DresdenCup 2023 will be conducted in accordance with the current ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications and the Technical Requirements for ISU Adult Figure Skating Competitions for season 2022-2023.

The teams must belong to an ISU Member. All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in this Announcement and they meet the participation requirements.

All programs will be judged in accordance with ISU Com. 2471, Com. 2501, Com. 2486, Com. 2487 and Com. 2491. The categories Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile and Non ISU Basic Novice coincides with the category ISU Basic Novice. The Requirements for the Adult category coincides with the ISU Adult Figure Skating Competitions for season 2022-2023. In case of changes, the current ISU Communication will always apply.

Categories and Technical Rules

ISU – CATEGORY:

ISU Advanced Novice - Free Skating

ISU Junior - Short Program & Free Skating

ISU Senior - Short Program & Free Skating

ISU Senior ELITE 12 - Free Skating

Technical requirements INTERCLUB – CATEGORY:

Age requirements: 80% of the Team must fulfill the age requirement corresponded to the category. For the other 20% a permissible age deviation of +/-2 years is permitted for Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile and Non ISU Basic Novice, a permissible age deviation of -3 years is permitted for Adult. The 80% / 20% rule applies according to the number of Skaters of a team stated in the team entry:

Pre Juvenile: shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. Before July 1st 2022 the skaters must have not reached the age of 10.

Free skating program 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
The Program Components Factor is 2.67

Juvenile: shall consist of 8 -16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. Before July 1st 2022 the skaters must have not reached the age of 13.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
The Program Components Factor is 2.67

Non ISU shall consist of 8 -16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters.
Basic Novice: Before July 1st 2022 the skaters must have reached the age of 10 and have not reached the age of 15.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
The Program Components Factor is 2.67

Mixed Age: shall consist of 8 -16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters, no age limit.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec);
The Program Components Factor is 2.67.

Lifts and un-sustained lifts of any variety and vaults are no longer permitted (Com. 2471, rule 992 p.2c).

Adult: shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. Before July 1st the skaters must have reached the age of 21. A maximum of 20% must have reached at least the age of eighteen (18) before 1st July 2022.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 1.67

Technical requirements ISU – CATEGORY:

ISU Advanced Novice: shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. Before July 1st 2022 all of them must have reached at least the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 15.

Free Skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 2.67

If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during Competition, the Team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 skaters.

ISU Junior: according to ISU regulations shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least 13 years and have not reached the age of 19 before the 1st of July 2022

If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during Competition, the Team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 skaters.

Short Program: 2.50 min (but may be less)
Program Components Factor is 1.33

Free Skating program: 3,30 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 2.67



ISU Senior: according to ISU regulations shall consist of 16 skaters with a maximum number 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least 15 years before the 1st of July 2022.

If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during Competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 14 skaters.

Short Program: 2.50 min (but may be less)
Program Components Factor is 1.33

Free Skating program: 3,30 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 2.67

ISU Senior Elite 12: shall consist of 12 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters.

Before July 1st 2022 all of them must have reached at least the age of 15

If an injury/illness should occur during official practice or during Competition, the team will be permitted to skate with not less than 11 skaters.

Free skating program: 4,00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 2.67

Entries and Entry Fee

All entries have to be sent to the Organizing Committee (OC) of the DresdenCup 2023 via email:

Please use the Preliminary Entry Form to indicate your team's participation in the competition. The preliminary entry form has to be submitted no later than 21. October 2022. Final entries have to be submitted no later than **25th of November 2022**. Please, also enclose a team photo.

The fixed entry fee for the third DresdenCup will be only 450,00 EUR for all interclub categories and 500,00 EUR for all ISU categories. The due date for the entry fee payment is the 25th of November 2022 and has to be made to the following bank account:

Please note, that the entry fee payment does not include extra practice ice nor any offered meals at the competition.

No refunds can be given after the 25th of November 2022.

PPC

The planned program content must be sent to the Organizing Committee before 25th of November 2022. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet is filled in precisely by each team in English, using the terminology for the elements listed in the Scale of Value Table published in ISU Commission. The Planned Program Content Sheet has to be signed by the coach or team manager of the participating team.

Music

All teams have to provide their competition music of excellent quality as an MP3-File via email before 25th of November 2022.

Please send the music as an MP3-file to: dresdencup@web.de. The respective email should only contain one music file or file link. The subject of the email must be clearly identified and should be labeled in the format "category, team name and exact duration of the program".

Additionally, each team shall bring along a labeled CD or USB-Stick with the music of the Free Program and Short Program.

Registration

The registration for Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators, Teams, Accredited Coaches, Team Leaders and Team Managers will take place at the designated registration office in the "Joynext Arena" on February 18th, 2023, starting at 7.30 a.m. All registered skaters have to submit a copy of their passport or ID card (EU citizens only) when they sign in. Passports copies have to be collected for the referee of the competition.

Draw

The starting order for the competition will be drawn electronically prior to the event. The result of the draw will be published on the competition website no later than 7:00 p.m. on Friday, February 17, 2023.

Official Practice and Unofficial Extra Practice Ice

The official practice will start on Saturday, February 18, 2023 approximately around 8.00 a.m. (The schedule is subjected to change!) Each Interclub team will be allowed a 10 (ten) minute period of official practice ice, which is already included in the entry fee. Junior and Senior teams will be allowed a 10 (ten) minute period for their short program. ISU Advanced Novice, ISU Junior ISU Senior and ISU Senior Elite 12 teams will be allowed a 12 (twelve) minute period of official practice ice for their free skating. The official practice is already included in the entry fee. No other music but the short program and free program music will be played during the official practice segments.



Once the music has started it will be played through in its entirety with no interruption. The music will be played twice during each official practice session.

If you require extra practice ice, please make your reservation no later than 25th of November 2022.

We kindly ask you to send your preferred time slots to the OC via email: dresdencup@web.de.

Depending on the demand we reserve the right to arrange the time slots for each team accordingly.

Extra practice ice will only be available on Friday, February 17th, 2023 from 12.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

The organizer will charge 60 € per 15 minutes on the ice. The confirmation of the fixed time slot for the extra practice session and the invoice with the date of payment will be sent to you via email.

Awards

A trophy will be presented to the winning team in each category. Further, the three best-placed teams will be awarded medals. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

Transportation and Ice Rink

Teams arriving by bus may use the designated pick-up/drop-off area in front of the Joynext Arena (Magdeburger Str. 10). Buses cannot park there, but may use one of the parking places in close

proximity to the ice rink. If you need any help in finding a suitable parking spot or means of transportation, please contact the OC.

The transportation is granted to the Technical Panel, Referees and Judges.

The ice rink "JoynextArena" is located at Magdeburger Straße 10, not far from the city center of Dresden. Easy to be reached: 20 minutes by car from Dresden International Airport, 10 minutes by car from the main railroad station.

The "JoynextArena" consists of three ice rinks, a three field sports hall and a ballet room. The competition will be held at the main ice rink called "Arena".

The "Arena" has a capacity of 3099 seats and a total capacity of 4.412 people. The ice surface has a size of 30m x 60m. The spectator and team area will be heated during the competition.

Meals

During the competition the restaurant "Sportsbar Ostra", located within the Joynext Arena, will provide a buffet for the teams upon request. An extra fee will be charged per meal and per team member.

It is possible to order dinner in the evening on the day of arrival in the respective team hotels, and we also offer the teams dinner in the Sportsbar Ostra on Saturday.

Please, notify the OC (dresdencup@web.de) until January 10, 2023 if you wish to book lunch and/or dinner at the restaurant.

Judges Meeting / Technical Panel Meeting

The Judges and Technical Panel Meeting will be held on Friday, February 17th, 2023 at 6.00 p.m. - 7.00 p.m. at the official hotel (Maritim Hotel). The Official Dinner will be held at 7.30 p.m.

Medical Information

Each team manager should be able to give important medical information for each skater for use in case of an emergency or accident. Such information should include but is not limited to the following, and will greatly help local medical and emergency personnel: allergies, existing medical conditions (i.e. asthma), current medications, immunizations, blood type, use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule, the Dresdner Eislauf-Club e.V. (organizer) accepts no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors or officials. The organizer will not provide participant insurance coverage for the event. Each club or team is expected to provide its own insurance protection.

The organizer will provide emergency medical services for all participants during the competition and official practice.



Publicity Waiver

Each individual/team waives any and all rights to financial remuneration or other compensation for the use and reproduction of their image or likeness, and grant permission to use the same prior to, during and following the DresdenCup 2023 in Dresden, Germany.
